WHEREAS, the Board of Education has received and considered the opinion of a licensed asbestos removal contractor, declaring the removal of tile with mastic asbestos from the Elementary School Library as an emergency project; and

WHEREAS, the emergency project is essential for the protection of the health and safety of the students and staff and for the protection of the District's property.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

- 1. The Board of Education hereby finds, pursuant to the Education Law, that the removal of tile with mastic asbestos from the Elementary School Library is essential for protection of the health and safety of the students and staff and for protection of the District's property, and hereby declares the Project to be an ordinary contingent expense (hereinafter "Project").
- 2. The maximum estimated cost of the Project, as determined by the School Business Official, is approximately (\$60,000). The funding source for the Project will be the General Fund balance, and to the maximum extent possible, state building aid.
- 3. The Superintendent of Schools and all officers and employees of the District are hereby authorized and directed to take all steps reasonably necessary or appropriate to complete the Project and to carry out the intent of this Resolution and to apply for any eligible state building aid.
- 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
