IMPORTANT NOTICE ABOUT PROPERTY TAXES

- This is the only tax bill you will receive. Please read front of tax statement for information about the penalty-free period and additional penalties.
- Delayed receipt of this bill does not change the payment or penalty schedules.
- If payment is made by mail, the Post Office Postmark will be used as the date of receipt. By law, a postage meter cancellation is NOT acceptable.
- If you have an escrow account, send this tax bill to your bank immediately.
- If you have sold this property, immediately forward this tax bill to the new owner.
- If there appears to be an error of any kind on this bill, please notify your assessor immediately. The presence of errors and/or omissions will not prevent the charging of interest or penalties after the initial due date.

SENIOR CITIZEN EXEMPTION

If you are age 65 or older and reside on this property, you may be eligible for a Low Income Senior Citizen exemption for county, town, village and school taxes. Contact your town assessor for information.

ASSESSMENT REVIEW PROCESS

If you feel your property is overvalued, you have the right to seek a review of your assessment. A publication entitled "Contesting Your Assessment" is available at your assessor's office and online at www.tax.ny.gov.

THIRD PARTY NOTIFICATION

If you are either 65 years of age or older or disabled, and you own and occupy a 1, 2 or 3 family residence, you may designate a consenting adult third party to receive duplicate copies of your tax bills and notices of unpaid taxes until further notice. Applications may be obtained from your County Real Property Tax Service, providing you send a request with a self-addressed stamped envelope.
