Board of Education Vice President Joseph Callaghan noted that 4th Grade teacher Jeffrey Liebentritt has been doing a weekly science project in his class that has been well received by students and aligns with the district STEAM initiative.

Superintendent Recognitions & Updates

Superintendent Matthew Frahm spoke about Building Maintenance Mechanics Shawn Mason and Jim Delgatto noting some of the great work that they do. Mr. Frahm indicated that they are the focus of his “Bright Spot”.

Mr. Frahm spoke about FIRST LEGO Robotics; it’s alignment with the districts STEAM initiative, and introduced students who participated in a recent robotics challenge. Students on the FIRST LEGO Robotics team demonstrated their programming and talked about the various skills that they employed through the challenge.

School Counselors Monica Kastner and Bill Murphy presented a career counseling department report and outlined various resources that the department and district has to offer students, especially in the areas of STEAM.

Mr. Frahm spoke about a meeting that he attended with other area Superintendents where Senate Majority Leader Flanagan presented noting some various questions that were put forward to the Senator and his responses.

Mr. Frahm wished everyone a Happy Thanksgiving.

Administrative Reports

Elementary Principal Kristina Saucke outlined items that appeared in the monthly Board of Education Report and spoke briefly about math coaching through W-FL BOCES, focusing on math as it aligns with STEAM, establishment of grade levels goals and priorities, clear curriculum mapping, focusing on standards versus modules, establishing common assessments, vertical and horizontal curriculum alignment, and the inclusion of special education and specialists in the programming. Ms. Saucke also noted that Veterans will be attending an upcoming Rally in Valley in their honor.

Secondary Principal Justin Stuck outlined items that appeared in the monthly Board of Education Report and spoke briefly about math coaching, math curriculum mapping, the shared decision making team initiatives, and upcoming Operation Santa events.

Director of Pupil Personnel Services Karen Mead outlined items that appeared in the monthly Board of Education Report and spoke briefly about programs that are utilized by students in our district, in W-FL BOCES, and throughout the region. Ms. Mead also gave an update on the state review process.

Student Representative Elizabeth Friend spoke briefly about the interscholastic sports programs, records, and awards; extracurricular activities; student academics, student activities; and student clubs.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that for calendar year 2015 compliance only the District shall utilize a transitional first standard look back measurement period of six (6) months which would run from April 13th of 2014 through October 12th of 2014, an administrative period running October 13, 2014 through to December 31, 2014, and a first standard stability period from January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015.

WHEREAS, the Patient Protection and Affordable Care act (the “Act”) and the regulations promulgated thereunder authorize employers to utilize initial measurement, administrative and stability periods to determine whether new variable hour, part-time, and seasonal employees constitute full-time employees under the Act; and

WHEREAS, the District wishes to adopt corrected initial measurement, administrative, and stability periods for the purposes of determining whether new variable hour, part-time, and seasonal employees constitute full-time employees under the Act.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the initial measurement period for new variable hour, part-time, and seasonal employees shall be a period of twelve (12) months that commences on the first day of the calendar month following an employee's first day of work; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the stability period for new variable hour, part-time, and seasonal employees shall be a period of twelve (12) months commencing on the day after the end of the employee's administrative period.

Here is some of the great events and professional learning happening at Naples Elementary:

Collaboration with our new BOCES Coaches for Math and Social Studies:

- Melissa Kerrick continues to work with our staff to provide coaching in the area of social studies. She has had initial coaching meetings with Grades UPK-4 and will have follow-up meetings with them before the Holidays. Katie Infantino (Media Specialist), Julie Austin (Music) and Abby Caste (Art and Art Tech) have joined grade levels to work on our content integration plan. 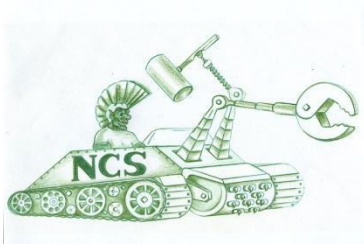

Out-of-District Special Education Programs Utilized by Naples CSD

Wayne-Finger Lakes BOCES - Finger Lakes Secondary School

6:1:1 and 6:1:1 Day Treatment programs provide small-group instruction with behavioral supports and group/individual counseling. Other related services available include speech-language therapy, occupational therapy, physical therapy and assistive technology services. The Day Treatment Program works in conjunction with mental health services and providers from Elmira Psychiatric Center. Day Treatment services include a family / home counseling component to support the student in all environments.

Honeoye CSD 12:1:1 CORAL (Challenging Others to Be Responsible, Active Learners) Program

The 12:1:1 CORAL Program helps students in grade 7 through age 21 to develop independent living skills and readiness to enter the work force upon completion of their high school career. The majority of instruction is hands-on and project-based learning, helping the students to gain experiences and make valuable connections to the newly introduced concepts. The teachers and program help to support students in the attainment of a CDOS (Career Development and Occupational Studies) Credential. Student may be identified for completion of New York State Assessments or the New York State Alternate Assessment (NYSAA).

School of the Holy Childhood

The School of the Holy Childhood serves student with Intellectual Disabilities and Multiple Disabilities. Students may attend through age 21 and participate in the transition programs, preparing the students for adult services and an active life in their community.

The program consists of 8:1:1 classes for younger students. The intermediate and secondary classrooms are 12:1:1, and emphasize preparing students for life beyond graduation. The Transition Program is a component which focuses on job skills, vocational training, self-advocacy, life skills and more. Students attend vocational classes within the agency and then

begin to try out jobs at Holy Childhood and out in the community with the assistance of a job coach. Individual schedules are developed based on needs and interests.
