Public Comment: Guest Pauline Preston stated she is concerned about the use of volunteers at the school adding that she feels volunteers should be investigated as closely as a regular school employee. Mrs. Preston also noted that the school needs to be sure that volunteers are not used to replace positions eliminated in the 20010-11 budget as that would go against the CSEA contract.

#### Superintendent Updates:

Superintendent Ward presented Victor Tomaselli and Kurt Vater of SEI Design Group and Chris Iversen of Iversen Construction who presented an update pertaining to the proposed Capital project, adding that the Facilities Committee members have been keeping the board informed throughout the process however they felt this would be a good time for SEI Design & Iversen Construction to give the board a quick overview of where we are with the capital project.

Mr. Tomaselli presented an overview of the proposed project, updating the board on the progress that has been made on the proposed project as well as information pertaining to maximum cost allowance, projected vote dates, meetings with SED, various design options, financial information and proposed timeline. Discussion was held pertaining to the information presented.

School Business Administrator Ann O'Brien updated the board on changes to Wincap, the school's financial program, stating the district is changing the school's requisition process by inputting the requisitions at the building or department level so the requisitions would be entered into Wincap, go through the electronic approval process and then the business office would simply print out the purchase order, adding the building principals and department heads will have access to Wincap so they will be able to keep tabs on the amount of money in their department's accounts, noting there will be additional individual training for the participants through the summer and fall.

Superintendent Ward updated the board on the piano, stating the board was unsure if the piano was donated by the Meeker family or the Moore family, adding each family had stated they trusted the board to make the decision as to whether they should dispose of the piano, repair the piano, or offer to give the piano away. Superintendent Ward stated guest Andrew Sherwood suggested that the school canvas for donations to cover the cost of repairs to the piano. Board Member Joseph Callaghan stated he agreed with Andy Sherwood and suggested the school take six months to see if it could raise the money for repairs. Board President Keith Swank agreed with the suggestion. Superintendent Ward suggested the school could put information on the school's website and also make information available at concerts as well. Discussion followed pertaining to the information presented and options given.

Board Member Mona Sage-Cardinale distributed a copy of a Donation Form developed by the Shared Decision Making Team to be used when an individual person donates something other than money to the school, which would include information on the donor, what they would like to donate and the information used to determine if the District is able to accept or decline the donation, also explaining that once an item is donated to the District it becomes District property and the District will make all further decisions regarding its use.

Board Member Margo Ulmer presented Policy Committee updates, commenting on the policies recently reviewed by the Policy Committee including: Foreign Travel, Fixed Assets, Naming Facilities, Energy Conservation, Use of Buildings, and Erie I BOCES Policy review.

Superintendent Ward asked for volunteers to serve on the board Audit Committee. Barbara Howard, Gail Musnicki, and Keith Swank volunteered to serve on the committee.
