Superintendent Updates: Interim Superintendent Gerald Macaluso welcomed the students, parents & staff in attendance, stating he truly enjoyed seeing so many people in attendance and thanked them coming.

Public Comment: NTA President Dan Robinson thanked Mr. Macaluso on behalf of the NTA & Support Staff for all of his work during his time as interim Superintendent.

> Superintendent Macaluso commended this year's participants in the Naples Special Olympics Team: Jaycie Harris, Elizabeth Ashmead, Joshua Hough, Cameron Rennoldson and Nikita Templeton, stating what a great job the students did representing Naples Central School. Mr. Macaluso also commended the staff and peer leaders who worked with the students, including Priscilla Kreuger, Stephanie Storms, Trisa Harvey, Tracy Savard, Ashley McArdle, Halayna Iverson, Leah Leach and Anna Kate Beigel, preparing them for the competition.

Mr. Macaluso then commended the Naples FIRST Robotics team for their great success in developing their robot for competition. The robotics team advisor, Physics teacher Patrick Freivald, demonstrated the basic idea of this year's competition along with some of the FIRST Robotics team members, explaining the team had six weeks to design and build the robot for the competition. Mr. Freivald stated students are enthusiastic about participating in the Robotics team, adding approximately 27 students attended a meeting just held for those interested in participating on the 2009-2010 team. The Board of Education expressed their appreciation for the hard work and success the Robotics Team has shown and applauded the student members and their advisors present at the meeting.

Mr. Macaluso then congratulated the Naples Colorguard on their fine season. Colorguard advisor Barb Hawks commended the team members stating there were 12 students on the team this year, ranging from 5th-12th grade and even though the team was very young they placed 9th out of 33 teams in the regionals and 33rd out of 139 teams in the Semi-Finals, adding she was very proud of the hard work and dedication the students had shown throughout the year. Mr. Macaluso again extended his congratulations to the team.

Board President Keith Swank thanked the staff, students and guests for attending.

Deputy Superintendent Brenda Keith presented an update on the Naples Community Park. Mrs. Keith presented an overview of how the park was developed, from the first idea by a group of concerned parents who wanted a safer venue for their children to play Babe Ruth Baseball to the approximately 200 people who were involved in developing the initial concept for the park, to the June 2007 Dedication of the Park and the continued updates to the Park since that time. Mrs. Keith explained that currently the Park is used for JV & V Soccer Practice, Naples Youth Soccer, Babe Ruth, Walking Trails, Picnics, etc., adding the newest addition is Disc Golf. Mrs. Keith stated a running track is currently under development as well as a Varsity Baseball Field adding a closed pavilion is also under review. Deputy Superintendent Keith commended the community for their hard work and support in developing the Park and requested any suggestions be referred to the Naples Community Park Foundation.

Board Reports:

Director of Pupil Personnel Kristina Saucke thanked the Board of Education for allowing her to attend a conference on Special Education Law, stating it was very informative. Ms. Saucke stated her department is currently working to complete the data collection required by NYS which is due in July, adding information for grants are also due July 1st. Ms. Saucke remarked at the wonderful time the staff had at the retirement party held for Brenda Keith, Sandra Mulligan, Mary Jo Watson and John Murphy at Bristol Harbor, adding they will all be missed.

Director of Curriculum & Instruction Lynn Strang stated there is a lot of reporting this time of year and they are in the process of checking over all of the data as because of the small size of our district even a small error in one or two students makes a significant change in the school's final data. Mrs. Strang commended the NSA (Naples School Association) for their success with the 6th Grade Fun Night, adding the NSA did a great job organizing the event and it was very well attended by students and parents.

Secondary Principal Norlyn Legler announced the 7th & 8th Grade Awards ceremony was very well attended and a great success.; The Yearbook Assembly was dedicated to this year's retirees.; The American Red Cross Blood Drive was a great success with 50 pints of blood donated.; Team Sugarbee, organized by English teacher Joelle Grifa in memory of her nephew, Joey Hayden, raised \$2,128 dollars for the 13th annual Stroll for Strong Kids, benefiting the Golisano Children's Hospital at Strong. Great Job!

Deputy Superintendent Keith announced that the school had just received notification from the NYS Department of Transportation that our Transportation Department received a 97.8% approval rating for the 2008-2009 School Year, commending Rocky Dean and Ron Clark for their hard work in maintaining our buses.
