RESOLVED, that the Supplemental Bond Resolution dated October 3, 2018 of the Board of Education of the Naples Central School District authorizing general obligation bonds to finance certain capital improvements, authorizing the issuance of bond anticipation notes in contemplation thereof, the levy of taxes in annual installments in payment thereof, the expenditure of such sums for such purpose, and determining other matters in connection therewith is hereby accepted as presented:

WHEREAS, the qualified voters of the Naples Central School District, New York, at a special meeting of such voters duly held on May 16, 2017, duly approved a proposition authorizing certain capital improvements at an estimated maximum aggregate cost of \$7,725,000, and by a bond resolution, dated June 7, 2017 (the "Original Bond Resolution"), the Board of Education of the Naples Central School District duly authorized such capital improvements and the financing therefor; and

WHEREAS, the qualified voters of the Naples Central School District, New York, at a special meeting of such voters duly held on September 11, 2018, duly approved a proposition authorizing the levy of taxes to be collected in installments, in the manner provided by the Education Law, to finance an estimated maximum aggregate additional cost of \$2,350,000 for such purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education, acting as lead agency under the State Environmental Quality Review Act and the applicable regulations promulgated thereunder ("SEQRA"), has completed its environmental review and, on March 27, 2017, has duly issued a negative declaration and has determined that the implementation of the type I action as proposed will not result in any significant adverse environmental impacts; now therefore

# BE IT RESOLVED BY THIS BOARD OF EDUCATION AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The Naples Central School District shall undertake certain capital improvements to the School District's existing school buildings and facilities, as more particularly described in Section 3 hereof, and as generally outlined to and considered by the voters of the School District at a special voter meeting on September 11, 2018.

- <u>Section 2</u>. The Naples Central School District is hereby authorized to issue its additional General Obligation Serial Bonds in the additional aggregate principal amount of not to exceed \$1,230,000, pursuant to the Local Finance Law of New York, in order to finance the class of objects or purposes described herein, and such additional amount is hereby appropriated therefor.
- Section 3. The class of objects or purposes to be financed pursuant to this resolution (hereinafter referred to as "purpose") is certain capital improvements previously approved by the voters of the School District on May 16, 2017, consisting of construction and reconstruction of school buildings and facilities within the School District (each such building being a class "A" (fireproof and certain fire resistant) building as defined in Subdivision 11 of Paragraph a of Section 11.00 of said Local Finance Law), various site improvements, and the acquisition of certain original furnishings, equipment, and apparatus and other incidental improvements required in connection therewith for such construction and school use.
- Section 4. It is hereby determined and declared that (a) the aggregate maximum additional cost of said purpose, as estimated by the Board of Education, is \$2,350,000, resulting in a revised total project cost of \$10,075,000; and (b) the Naples Central School District's plan to finance the cost of said purpose is (i) to provide \$1,120,000 from the existing capital reserve fund for such costs; and (ii) to provide up to \$1,230,000 from funds raised by the issuance of said Bonds and the Bond Anticipation Notes hereinafter referred to, with the balance of the financing to be issued under the Original Bond Resolution; and (c) no money has heretofore been authorized to be applied to the payment of the cost of said purpose.
- <u>Section 5</u>. It is hereby determined that the purpose is one of the class of objects or purposes described in Subdivision 12 of Paragraph a of Section 11.00 of the Local Finance Law, and that the period of probable usefulness of said purpose is twenty (20) years.
- <u>Section 6</u>. The Naples Central School District is hereby authorized to issue its additional Bond Anticipation Notes in the aggregate principal amount of not to exceed \$1,230,000 and is hereby authorized to issue renewals thereof, pursuant to the Local Finance Law of New York in order to finance the purpose in anticipation of the issuance of the above described Bonds.
- Section 7. It is hereby determined and declared that (a) there are presently no outstanding Bond Anticipation Notes issued in anticipation of the sale of said additional Bonds, (b) the Bond Anticipation Notes authorized hereby shall mature within one year of the date of issuance thereof or such longer term as may be desired in accordance with the provisions of the Local Finance Law, (c) the Bond Anticipation Notes authorized hereby are not issued in anticipation for Bonds for an assessable improvement, and (d) current funds will be provided prior to the issuance of the Bonds or Bond Anticipation Notes herein authorized, to the extent, if any, required by Section 107.00 of the Local Finance Law.
- Section 8. It is hereby determined and declared that the Naples Central School District reasonably expects to reimburse the general fund, or such other fund as may be utilized, not to exceed the maximum amount authorized herein, from the proceeds of the obligations authorized hereby for expenditures, if any, from such fund that may be made for the purpose prior to the date of issuance of such obligations. This is a declaration of official intent under Treasury Regulation §1.150-2.
- Section 9. The faith and credit of the Naples Central School District, New York, are hereby irrevocably pledged for the payment of the principal of and interest on such Bonds and Bond Anticipation Notes as the same respectively become due and payable. An annual appropriation shall be made in each year sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on such obligations becoming due and payable in such year. There shall annually be levied on all taxable real property of said School District, a tax sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on such obligations as the same become due and payable.

# Regular Meeting

Section 10. The power to further authorize the issuance of said Bonds and Bond Anticipation Notes and to prescribe the terms, form and contents of said Bonds and Bond Anticipation Notes, subject to the provisions of this resolution and the Local Finance Law of New York, including without limitation, the authority to determine whether to accept bids electronically to the extent allowed by the Local Finance Law, the consolidation with other issues, the determination to issue Bonds with substantially level or declining annual debt service, all contracts for, and determinations with respect to credit or liquidity enhancements, if any, and to sell, issue and deliver said Bonds and Bond Anticipation Notes, subject to the provisions of this resolution and Local Finance Law, is hereby delegated to the President of the Board of Education or to the Vice President of the Board of Education, Vice President and the District Clerk are hereby authorized to sign by manual or facsimile signature any Bonds and Bond Anticipation Notes issued pursuant to this resolution, and are hereby authorized to affix to such Bonds and Bond Anticipation Notes the corporate seal of the School District and to attest the same.

Section 11. This resolution, or a summary hereof, shall be published in full by the District Clerk of the School District together with a notice in substantially the form prescribed by Section 81.00 of said Local Finance Law, and such publication shall be in each official newspaper of the School District. The validity of said Bonds and Bond Anticipation Notes issued in anticipation of the sale of said Bonds may be contested only if such obligations are authorized for an object or purpose for which said School District is not authorized to expend money, or the provisions of law which should be complied with, at the date of publication of this resolution are not substantially complied with, and an action, suit or proceeding contesting such validity, is commenced within twenty (20) days after the date of such publication; or if said obligations are authorized in violation of the provisions of the Constitution.

Section 12. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
