A quorum being present, the Organizational meeting was called to order at 6:01 p.m. by District Clerk Pamela Claes.

Board President Jacob Hall discussed board committee signed-ups, asking board members to reach out to him and let him know what committees they would like to be a part of.

Superintendent Recognitions & Updates:

Board of Education Retreats - Superintendent Swartz noted he had built two board retreats into the schedule for the year.

Superintendent Swartz stated the District is in a pretty good place with hiring, noting over the past couple of weeks we have identified several Elementary teachers and the teachers there are now set noting we hired the last one, a Music teacher, on Monday, adding what remains is a High School Nurse, a High School Teacher Assistant for the RISE room and a School Bus Driver.

Superintendent Swartz stated today they had their administrator retreat and he felt conversations were very deep and honest, noting they had a very deep and honest discussion in terms of what they are feeling good about and what they are worried about going into the new year, noting the importance of being honest and open about the realities of what all districts will be facing over the next five to ten years and the many reasons we should still be optimistic and some of the common messages we should be sharing with all staff.; Mr. Swartz noted the District will have to look at tightening its belt as Federal funds begin to dry up but we can still offer a really strong education for our students. Mr. Swartz stated the District is in a good place financially with our reserves, where we can deal with some of the fiscal issues through attrition where a lot of other districts will have to consider lay-offs.; Superintendent Swartz noted they had also discussed how they District has navigated some tremendous emotional issues over the past couple of years.; Each of the administrators shared what their individual building or department goals were in relation to our District priorities and they also talked about the APPR process, making sure they are asking common questions of the teachers across the buildings, adding he feels it was time well spent.; Superintendent Swartz extended his thanks to everyone who helped make Graduation a success, adding overall the ceremony went well, extending a huge thanks to the Maintenance Department who really stepped up to move graduation indoors due to the rain.; New teacher orientation and what that will look like noting it will be held on August 2nd.

School Business Administrator Chad Hunt stated the EV Bus project is finally in the que at the state, noting once you get into the que it is usually about a twelve week wait so we would be looking at October for an approval, at which time we could go out to bid and they are hoping to have most of the work completed in November, except the asphalt repair which would have to wait until spring; the current capital project is going really well, noting the asbestos abatement across the street is complete and they are hoping to be able to get into a lot of the rooms on Monday; Advertising for bids is out and there will be a walkthrough on July 6th with the bid opening on July 27th at 3 p.m. in the District office and they are hoping to award contracts at the August 9th Board of Education meeting.; The Elementary School playground now has a snow fence around it as it has deteriorated so much it is swaying and they are trying to move up the demolition; Kurt Vater of SEI feels we are going to get a good turnout for the bids as he has received a number of calls from companies and feels we should get competitive pricing. Board Member Steven Mark asked what the bidding process entailed and School Business Administrator explained the process; Board Member Robert Brautigam asked what the

status of the 2022-23 Capital Outlay Project. Mr. Hunt stated they should be here to start the abatement on that project next week, noting the panels should be coming down, abatement completed and new panels put up, adding there was a delay waiting for some hardware for the project.; Mr. Hunt noted the bid for the 2023-2024 Capital Outlay Project would go out in the first week in August



PART 5 - CONTINUING ANNUAL SECONDARY MARKET DISCLOSURE OVER THE LIFE OF A BOND ISSUE TO COMPLY WITH CFR TITLE 17, SECURITIES EXCHANGE ACT OF 1934, AS AMENDED, SECTION 240.15c2-12

The above-referenced Section 240.15c2-12 requires the School District, as the issuer of \$1,000,000 or more, "to enter into a written agreement to provide certain event notices and/or annual financial information to the Electronic Municipal Market Access ("EMMA") system maintained by the Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board ("MSRB')." The regulation makes it unlawful for a broker or underwriter to purchase and reoffer the School District's issue unless the broker has verified that the School District has undertaken the above-referenced "written agreement or contract for the benefit of the bond holders." Services rendered to assist with compliance will depend directly upon the amount and type of indebtedness incurred by the School District and will be billed at the firm's hourly rate.

- (5.1) **FULL DISCLOSURE** - The School District is required to annually prepare and file a secondary market disclosure official statement (financial information and operating data); audited annual reports, if any; and Material Event Notices to MSRB's EMMA system, if the School District's total outstanding indebtedness, including the current issue, exceed \$10,000,000. We can assist with the collection and filing of the required information as annually required and as Event Notices are received from the School District.
- (5.2) **LIMITED DISCLOSURE** - The School District is required to provide, at a minimum, certain annual financial information and operating data which is customarily prepared by the School District and is publicly available and a copy of the audited financial statements to MSRB's EMMA system. We can assist with the collection and filing of the required information as annually required and as Event Notices are received from the School District, if the School District's total outstanding indebtedness, including the current issue, is less than \$10,000,000.

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- (5.3) **LIMITED DISCLOSURE - EVENT NOTICES ONLY** - The School District is required to file certain "Event Notices" to the MSRB's EMMA system. When "Events" occur during the life of the issue, a determination is needed by Bond Counsel, and we can assist with the filing of the "Event Notices" after being notified by the School District as "Events" occur.

PART 6 - IRS ARBITRAGE REBATE OR PENALTY TRACKING AND CALCULATION IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1954, AS AMENDED, SECTION 148

The President of the Board of Education will make certifications in the closing documents prepared by Bond Counsel for the Note or Bond confirming compliance with the IRS Arbitrage Regulations §1.148. If available, the Board President will elect "Penalty" or "Rebate" on IRS Form 8038-G filed with the IRS at the time of closing on the issue. The District must track the receipt of the issue proceeds, interest earned thereon, and payments made to the IRS, as agreed to by the Board President in the closing "Arbitrage Certificate" so that the issue remains exempt from, federal, state, and local income tax under §148 of the Tax Code.

The following items will be completed at the firm's hourly rate, on an as needed basis to comply with the Internal Revenue Service Code:

- (6.1) **Determine Arbitrage Impact** on various borrowing scenarios based on "what ifs" applied to variable criteria which can affect amount of Rebate/Penalty and, consequently, amount of interest earned payable to the Internal Revenue Service.
- (6.2) **Track specific proceeds** of each issue, so the District may remain in compliance with the Internal Revenue Code, using approved Government Finance Officers Association guidelines, procedures and tracking tools. The necessary raw data will be requested by our firm and the monthly tracking accomplished with reports and recommendations to the District on optional spending patterns.
- (6.3) **Perform Arbitrage Rebate/Penalty Analysis and calculations** to determine amount of Rebate or Penalty, if any, payable to the Internal Revenue Service.
- (6.4) **Assist in the completion of the Internal Revenue Service Form 8038-T, "Arbitrage Rebate and Penalty in Lieu of Arbitrage Rebate"**, which must be filed with any Arbitrage Rebate/Penalty payment made to the IRS, in compliance with Section 148 of the Internal Revenue Code.
- (6.5) **Compile an audit trail document** showing transactions related to the issue's proceeds. The calculation of the "spend down" thresholds and any penalty or rebate will be included. The documentation will be provided to the District at completion of tracking the expenditure of the issue proceeds or in the interim for an IRS compliance audit, if required.

- (6.6) Assist in the preparation for, and **attend any worksessions** and/or meetings if and when an **IRS Audit** takes place regarding Section 148 of the IRS Tax Code dealing with arbitrage review.

PART 7 - FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT SERVICES

The following representative items may be completed at the request of the Board of Education or School Administrators under this portion of the contract:

- (7.1) Assist in the creation of a **projected cash flow** for the project.

- (7.11) Complete the **SA-23, "Request for Building Aid Estimate"** for execution and filing by the District Officials. This assumes the District has received the "Approval of Plans and Specifications" and "Bond Certificate" from the State Education Department.
- (7.12) Provide a tracking document for various State Aid forms to enhance awareness of the District for timely and sequential filing with Facilities Planning, General Aids and Services and School District Reorganization, where appropriate.



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- (7.13) Assist in the preparation of various New York **State Department of Education forms and reports** pertaining to the Capital project.
- (7.14) If required by arbitrage rules, coordinate the investment in State & Local Government Series in cooperation with the local bank of account, bond counsel and the Federal Reserve Bank in New York City.
- (7.15) Assist with **credit rating review** and/or conference call for bond sale or surveillance call as needed by Credit Rating Agency.

The charge for any Financial Management Services will be \$195 per hour plus out-of-pocket expenses. The rate will be adjusted each July 1 by the change in the Consumer Price Index, All Urban Consumers - Northeast Urban Rate, for the time period July 1 through June 30.

- PART 4 - REVENUE BOND FINANCING PROGRAM THROUGH DORMITORY AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK (DASNY)** - Vouchers will be submitted directly to the Escrow bank prior to funding.
- PART 5 - CONTINUING ANNUAL SECONDARY MARKET DISCLOSURE** - Vouchers will be submitted after verified filing of the required information with the specified repositories.
- PART 6 - IRS ARBITRAGE REBATE OR PENALTY TRACKING AND CALCULATION** - Vouchers may be submitted on a monthly basis.

**Memorandum of Agreement
between the
Naples Central School District

Naples Association of School Administrators

The Naples Central School District (hereinafter referred to as the “District”) and the Naples Association of School Administrators (hereinafter referred to as the “Association”) (collectively referred to as the “Parties”) are parties to a 2021-2025 collective bargaining agreement (hereinafter referred to as the “CBA”) and recognize:

1. Remote work may prove beneficial for certain unit members at the District during applicable break periods throughout the school year.
2. The Parties have met to discuss remote work and wish to resolve this matter amicably and in the best interest of both the Association and the District.

Therefore, the Parties agree as follows:

1. Unit members may be allowed up to ten (10) workdays per school year to work remotely when students and teachers are not in session (i.e., December Holiday Break, February Break, Spring Recess, and Summer Break).
2. If allowed to work remotely, each unit member must perform any and all duties associated with his/her position and be available to the District at any time during the normal workday. These remote workdays are not to be treated as additional paid time off.
3. All remote workdays must be requested and receive prior approval from the Superintendent or his/her designee. The decision to grant or deny a remote day is solely at the discretion of the Superintendent or his/her designee. All decisions will be made on a case-by-case basis.
4. Following the Superintendent or his/her designee’s approval, the remote day must be requested in WinCap Web to be processed.
5. This Agreement shall sunset and be considered null and void on August 31, 2025, unless the parties agree in writing for it to continue.

6. By their signature below, the Parties acknowledge the above understanding is being made based on the particular circumstances involved and that this agreement shall not serve as a precedent in any future application or interpretation of the collectively bargained agreement between the parties, except as stated therein.
