The certification area and status is School District Leader, Professional; Childhood Education (Grades 1-6), Professional; Early Childhood Education (Birth-Grade 2), Professional; Literacy (Birth-Grade 6), Professional; Students with Disabilities (Grades 1-6), Professional; Students of Disabilities (Birth-Grade 2), Professional. Salary for the 2024-2025 school year will be \$104,000 plus current administrative contract provisions.
