# Naples High School Profile 2019-20

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# **School & Community**

Naples is located at the south end of Canandaigua Lake in the heart of the Finger Lakes. The district encompasses approximately 118 square miles and has a population of about 4,500. The school is accredited by the New York State Board of Regents. In 2016 and 2017, US News & World Report awarded Naples with a Silver Medal, and a rank of 166 out of the 1,165 New York State high schools. The rankings were based on state proficiency standards, how well students are prepared for college, and several other factors.

### **Honors Program**

The Honors Program at Naples High School was developed in the 2015-16 school year to recognize our highest achieving students. Honors Program students must complete 5 of the 7 AP courses offered, as well as earn 15 credits through dual-credit classes.

# Schedule

The school year consists of two twenty-week semesters. Naples High School uses a six day schedule cycle. Each day consists of eight 41-minute periods. Full-credit courses meet each day. The average class size throughout the district is 16 students.

#### **Class Rank & Average**

All AP classes are weighted by 10 percent. Dual-credit courses are weighted by five percent. Rank and GPA are computed after semesters four, five, six, and seven. Rank is calculated by the cumulative averaging process and includes final numerical averages. The final grade for full-year courses is determined by averaging the four-quarter marks and final examination. Physical Education is included in the GPA.
