Regular Meeting

Public Comment:

Guest James Hall, as a representative of Cohocton Wind Watch, commented on the settlement between Naples Central School and First Wind, stating he feels that the school should be entitled to the full industrial tax rate. Mr. Hall stated the estimated number of turbines to be constructed in Italy and Prattsburgh is thirty-two. Mr. Hall stated the assessed value of the Ecogen Project is 1.5 Billion dollars over 20 years commending the District for taking legal action against the developers but stating the district should have received a larger settlement.

Guests Riley Hoselton asked that the Board of Education consider her request to allow her two sons, who are both homeschooled, to practice with the Naples Swim Team, emphasizing that they would not be participating in any of the swim meets against other teams. Mrs. Hoselton asked the Board of Education to review the Board Policy covering participation by homeschooled students in team activities, adding that homeschooled students are also a part of the school community.
