Board of Education Member Robert Brautigam spoke briefly about the High School Musical and Elementary Music in Our Schools Concert noting the quality of the programs.

Superintendent Matthew Frahm spoke about an upcoming tour of the Career and Technical Education Center at Wayne - Finger Lakes BOCES and new selections for Graduates of Distinction including Bruce Clawson, Bill Vierhile, Richard Konz, and Jane Schenk.

Superintendent Recognitions & Updates

Superintendent Matthew Frahm spoke about some "Points of Pride" including the Spelling Bee competition, swimming accomplishments, a swimming fundraiser, the Beauty and the Beast Musical, Zach Dormer in the Ronald McDonald senior game, and a recent Robotics Competition.

High School Science Teacher Jon Betrus spoke about a potential new High School elective course called "Outdoor Adventures".

Mr. Frahm spoke about a Regional Conference Day that was held at the Canandaigua Central School District noting some of the learning that came out of the day.

Mr. Frahm talked briefly about the Wayne - Finger Lakes Personalized Learning Consortium and spoke about how the Naples Central School District is doing a lot of work internally to promote voice and choice for students.

Mr. Frahm, Elementary School Principal Kristina Saucke, Teacher on Special Assignment Anneke Radin-Snaith, and High School Principal Elizabeth Ashton spoke about the District Priority/Goal of STEAM Enhancement. This was followed by a period of question and comment by the Board of Education.

Assistant Superintendent for Business Mitchell Ball presented a capital project update.

Administrative Reports

Student Representative Seth Price spoke briefly about interscholastic sports, extracurricular activities; charitable activities, student academics, student activities; and student clubs.

Director of Pupil Personnel Services Karen Mead outlined items that appeared in the monthly Board of Education Report and spoke briefly about the reduction of a Special Program in district and that over the next few years our students will no longer have access to the CORAL Program at the Honeoye Central School District.

Elementary School Principal Kristina Saucke outlined items that appeared in the monthly Board of Education Report and spoke briefly about 3-8 testing, the regional conference day and its impact on staff, tech integration at the Elementary School, Educon, and Maddiegras.

Secondary Principal Bridget Ashton outlined items that appeared in the monthly Board of Education Report and spoke briefly about academic achievements, Fine Arts and Music Departments as asset builders, some recent interscholastic sports achievements, and engaging opportunities for staff members in the district and region.

WHEREAS, the Naples Central School District (the District) seeks to undertake a district wide capital improvement project consisting of:

Acquisition of property consisting of approximately 3.82 acres contiguous to the Naples Central School District along Widmer Lane, located on North Main Street, in addition to renovations at the District's High School and Elementary School, including, but not limited to vehicular drive renovation, parking lot and sidewalk renovations, landscaping and building additions and renovations, as well as demolition of the existing bus facility and construction of a new bus maintenance facility to include security lighting, fencing, a storm water maintenance system, sanitary system, associated utilities and landscaping.

WHEREAS, the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA") and the regulations thereunder require the Board to undertake a review of the potential environmental impacts, if any, associated with the project before approving same; and

WHEREAS, this project is a Type 1 Action within the meaning of SEQRA; and

WHEREAS, on February 7, 2017, a notice was transmitted to all involved agencies of the Board's desire to act as lead agency with respect to the environmental review of the proposed Project; and

WHEREAS, no agency has objected to the designation of the Board as lead agency with respect to the environmental review of the proposed Project; and

WHEREAS, 6 NYCRR Section 617.7 requires a lead agency to Issue a written determination of significance with respect to any proposed Type 1 action;

WHEREAS, the Board has carefully considered the nature and scope of the proposed Project, as set forth in the Full Environmental Assessment Form prepared with respect to such action, and makes the following determinations:

1. The proposed action involves:

Acquisition of property consisting of approximately 3.82 acres contiguous to the Naples Central School District along Widmer Lane, located on North Main Street, in addition to renovations at the District's High School and Elementary School, including, but not limited to vehicular drive renovation, parking lot and sidewalk renovations, landscaping and building additions and renovations, as well as demolition of the existing bus facility and construction of a new bus maintenance facility to include security lighting, fencing, a storm water maintenance system, sanitary system, associated utilities and landscaping.

- 2. The proposed action is classified under SEQRA as a Type 1 action within the meaning of 6 NYCRR §617.4.
- 3. Upon consideration of the action, review of the Environmental Assessment Form, the criteria contained in 6 NYCRR §617.4, and all other supporting information, the Board identifies the following relevant areas of environmental concern, as set forth hereafter, and analyzes whether the proposed action may have a significant adverse impact on the environment.
- 4. The development and use of the property will result in a small to moderate impact on land during the period of construction since construction. Any impact to the land will be mitigated to the extent possible during the construction process.
- 5. The proposed development and use of the property will not adversely impact geological features.
- 6. The proposed development and use of the property will not adversely impact surface water.
- 7. The proposed development and use of the property will not adversely impact ground water.
- 8. The proposed development and use of the property will not adversely result in flooding.
- 9. The proposed development and use of the property will not adversely impact air.
- 10. The proposed development and use of the property will impact plants and animals as the result of the conversion of portions of a vineyard. The District, during construction, will take steps to minimize the extent of loss of flora or fauna.
- 11. The proposed development and use of the property will impact agricultural resources by the conversion of land in an agricultural district. The District seeks to utilize a minimal portion of land and will take steps to preserve the integrity of the surrounding agricultural property.
- 12. The proposed development and use of the property will have a small to moderate impact upon aesthetic resources. This impact will be minimized during design and the use of vegetative screening.
- 13. The proposed development and use of the property will not adversely impact historic or archeological resources. The District will comply with mitigation measures if any are recommended by SHPO.

14. The proposed development and use of the property will not adversely impact open space and recreation areas.

- 15. The proposed development and use of the property will not adversely impact critical environmental areas.
- 16. The proposed development and use of the property will not adversely impact transportation systems.
- 17. The proposed development and use of the property will not adversely impact energy.
- 18. The proposed development and use of the property will have a small to moderate impact upon noise, odor and light.
- 19. The proposed development and use of the property will have a small to moderate impact upon human health during the period of construction. Mitigation measures will be undertaken during the period of construction to minimize any impacts.
- 20. The proposed development and use of the property is consistent with community plans.
- 21. The proposed development and use of the property will have a small to moderate impact upon community character.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board finds and concludes that the proposed action is a Type 1 Action within the meaning of 6 NYCRR 617.4; and it is further

Shall the following resolution be adopted to wit:

RESOLVED, that the board of education of the Naples Central School District is hereby authorized to undertake certain capital improvements consisting of the acquisition of land, or rights in land, to include up to approximately 3.82 acres located contiguous to Naples Central School District property along Widmer Lane, and construction and reconstruction of school buildings and facilities, including, without limitation, school building reconstruction and demolition of the existing bus garage and the construction of a new bus garage, various site improvements and the acquisition of certain original furnishings, equipment, and apparatus and other incidental improvements required in connection therewith for such construction and school use, all at an estimated maximum aggregate cost of \$7,725,000; and to appropriate and expend from existing capital reserve funds \$3,730,000 for such costs, and that the balance of such costs, or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be raised by the levy of a tax to be collected in annual installments, with such tax to be offset by state aid available therefor; and, in anticipation of such tax, debt obligations of the school district as may be necessary not to exceed \$3,995,000 shall be issued. A metes and bounds legal description of such real property to be acquired will be available for inspection at such voter meeting and is incorporated and adopted herein.

NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that the text of the aforesaid proposition may appear on the ballot labels in the following abbreviated form:

PROPOSITION

Shall the proposition set forth in the legal notice of this annual voter meeting, authorizing acquisition by the Naples Central School District of approximately 3.82 acres of land located contiguous to the District property along Widmer Lane, and construction and reconstruction and equipping of school buildings and facilities, including, without limitation, school building reconstruction and bus garage demolition and the construction of a new bus garage, various site and incidental improvements, all at an estimated maximum aggregate cost of \$7,725,000; with the expenditure of \$3,730,000 from the existing capital reserve fund for such costs, the issuance of up to \$3,995,000 of debt obligations of the School District to finance the balance of such costs, and the levy of a tax in annual installments therefor, with such tax to be offset by state aid available therefor, all as more fully described in said notice, be approved?

The School District, acting as lead agency under the State Environmental Quality Review Act and the applicable regulations promulgated thereunder ("SEQRA"), has completed its environmental review and, on March 15, 2017, has duly issued a negative declaration and has determined that the implementation of the type I action as proposed will not result in any significant adverse environmental impacts.

2. At such meeting taxes to be levied by installments will be proposed providing for payment of such capital costs and providing for the financing costs therefor. Such taxes shall be

levied upon all the taxable property of the District, shall be levied in annual installments and shall be of such amounts and levied in such years as may be determined by the Board of Education.

I had the amazing opportunity to join six other staff members from both buildings (Bridget Ashton, Anneke Radin-Snaith, Carrie Grove, Ryan Betrus, Alyson Powers, and Michelle Walpole) to attend this national "innovation conference" in Philadelphia. Additionally, Anneke and I presented a session titled, "Appealing to the Heart, Getting the Most out of Teacher-Principal Relationships." It was a fantastic growth opportunity for me to do something out of my normal role and step into the world of staff developers. It is safe to say, Anneke is much more skilled in this area than I am! I was so grateful for the opportunity to step outside of my comfort

zone and help lead an engaging conversation on a topic that I value so highly.

For those of you who don't know, Educon a conference that we have sent staff to for the last 5 years. It started out with 2 faculty members and has increased to 7 this year. - Benchmarking of all students UPK-6 using Fountas and Pinnell text levels
- Staff newsletter "Learning Bytes" (with Anneke) to provide staff with updates and resources
- Assistance in organizing and creating a schedule for learning walks. Our next
 collaboration will be in April when UPK-2 teachers from Canandaigua, Marcus Whitman
 and Naples visit teachers at Midlakes. In May, these 3 districts will travel to Naples for
 a day of learning and collaboration at the primary level. ©

I am recommending that the Naples Board of Education approve Math 200: Intermediate Statistics as a course to be offered during the 2017/2018 school year. This would be a half year course, which would increase our elective math offerings to juniors and seniors. FLCC requires a pre-requisite of an 80 on the Algebra II Regents exam.

Course description:

This statistics course is designed for an experienced mathematics student. It is a one semester course covering descriptive and inferential statistics. Topics included are measures of center; measures of dispersion; hypothesis testing; estimations for population means, proportions, and variance; determination of sample size; uses of the Chi-square distribution; analysis of variance; linear correlation and linear regression; and statistical research. The course will emphasize computer or calculator use (graphing calculator, Minitab, Excel, or the like).

The course has many other additional benefits:

- Increase the rigor of senior year
- Provide course credits to our students—essentially free of charge
- Encourage more students to take a fourth/fifth year of math.
- Increase STEAM elective offerings

I am recommending that the Naples Board of Education approve Italian Conversation and Culture I and Italian Conversation and Culture II. Each would be a one semester course offered in the fall and spring, respectively. These courses would be open to students in grades 9-12. There are no pre-requisites, and would be electives added at engaging more students in language. culture, and increasing global perspectives (not a replacement of the current language tracks).

Course descriptions:

Italian Conversation and Culture I (Fall)

I am recommending that the Naples Board of Education approve Outdoor Adventures (Outdoors Tomorrow Foundation). This would be a full year course open to students in grades 9-12. There

are no pre-requisites, and should be approved as a graduation level science course. This course will help increase student engagement and increase our STEAM elective offerings.

<u>Course Description</u> - "Students are taught life-long skills by using as an integrated curriculum of science, math, writing, critical thinking skills, and computer technology." The class will cover a wide variety of topics that fit into the realm of Outdoor Education. Students will actively engage in developing many important skills that they can use for the rest of their lives. There will be a strong theme throughout the course that will emphasize the study of Ecology and Wildlife Conservation.

<u>Topics</u> - The topics covered in this course include, but are not limited to, Topics/Units

- Backpacking/Camping
- Wilderness Survival
- Compass and Map use Orientering
- GPS use and geocaching
- Edible Plant ID/Outdoor Cooking
- Wildlife Ecology and Identification
- Environmental Literature
- Boater Education
- Angler Education
- Fisheries and Wildlife Techniques
- Sportsmans Education (Hunter Ed & Bowhunter Ed)
- First Aid/CPR

<u>Activities</u> - Some of the activities that students will be involved in include, day hikes and extended backpacking/camping trips, mapping with compass, orienteering, GPS use, outdoor leisure sports that are fitting for the season, and wildlife and plant identification and Ecology.

Students will be expected to keep a field journal throughout the course to record their experiences. The class will also include 2 book discussions that have an Environmental or Conservation focus, ie. A Walk in the Woods.

As of this course proposal the offering is anticipated to be an elective offered to upper division science students first and then down from there as scheduling allows. The course is a 1 credit offering and runs through the entire school year.
